

REGULATIONS 2022 – ROHAN SCHOLARSHIP

The French Institute of Austria and the Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs provide "Séjour Scientifiques de Haut Niveau" grants for short stays in France.

GENERAL FRAMEWORK

These grants have an artistic component and can be awarded to Austrian artists or artists living in Austria who have a project for an artistic stay in France. This project must be part of an artist residency of one to three months in one of the institutions listed in Annex II. French nationality or dual nationality including French nationality exclude the granting of a French government scholarship. This year, the focus is on the visual and plastic arts, literature or translation. The Rohan Fellowship will be awarded to a single project in one of these disciplines. The grant is **1400€** per month.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The artist must :

- Speak French and/or English (knowledge of French is not a prerequisite but an asset when considering the application)
- Prove that he/she has produced several noteworthy works in the discipline for which he/she is applying
- Interrupt professional activities not directly related to the discipline during the entire period of stay

→ No age limit is imposed

TIMETABLE AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

- Applications must be sent by email to vienne@campusfrance.org until May 1, 2022
- Applications are received by the French Institute of Austria and examined by the cultural service. The best candidates will be invited to an interview
- Candidates will be informed of the results in June 2022

DURATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AND PERIOD OF ELIGIBLE MOBILITY

The candidate selected for the Rohan 2022 Scholarship will be able to start his/her mobility as of **July 1, 2022**. He/she must have completed the residency by **December 31, 2022** at the latest. The

residency must last between 1 and 3 months. An extension is not automatic and must be requested from the SCAC of the French Embassy in Austria. If the request is accepted, the scholar will be asked to prepare a new scholarship application. Any modification of the stay in relation to the information provided in this application must be requested from the Embassy, which reserves the right to refuse funding.

CONSTITUTION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

The application procedure for the Rohan 2022 Scholarship is made in two steps:

1. After having read these rules, fill out the form in Appendix I.
2. Send the documents mentioned below to vienne@campusfrance.org with the subject "ROHAN_Name" and respecting the nomenclature indicated in parentheses for each document and the deadlines indicated.

Any incomplete file sent after the deadline will be considered ineligible.

- CV (CV_name) in French or English (2 pages maximum)
- Description of your research and/or creation project (Description_name) in French or English (2 pages maximum)
- An artistic dossier (5 pages maximum) which may include links to websites, video or audio extracts, photographs, press articles, etc.
- A statement on honour guaranteeing that the works presented are those of the applicant
- Letter of invitation (Invitation_name): Letter of invitation from the host institution in French or English with the dates of stay
- If the applicant receives financial support from another partner, please attach their letter of commitment with details of their financial commitment.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- The management of French Government Scholarships is subcontracted to Campus France Paris.
- As a recipient of a French Government Scholarship, the scholarship holder will not be allowed to leave the country of residence until he/she has received his/her CampusPass (information on the services provided by Campus France: amount of the scholarship, accommodation, insurance). In all cases, the scholar must be in possession of an identity card.
- Upon arrival in France, the scholarship recipient must follow the CampusPass' instructions and contact the Campus France center in their region.
- It is not possible to combine the Rohan Scholarship with an apprenticeship or work contract, a grant from the Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs, an Erasmus + grant or a grant from the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie. In case of cumulation, the Rohan Scholarship will be automatically cancelled.

END OF STAY REPORT

- The end of the artistic residency must be the subject of a final report to be sent to vienna@campusfrance.org

- Publications of the beneficiary's work must mention the financial support of the French Embassy and the French Institute of Austria with the presence of their logo.
